



Preparing Your Fireplace for a Gasline Installation

- After completing the installation of your fireplace, determine from which side you will be running your gas supply line. It can be either the right or left side of your fireplace.
- 2. Place your Decorative Gas Appliance in the firebox and locate it in its' final position.
- 3. Find an area directly adjacent to your gas inlet to achieve the closest and most direct path for your gasline.
- 4. Drill a 3/4" hole in the side wall
- 5. Feed the supply line through the hole.
- 6. Seal around the hole and supply gas pipe with high temperature sealant.
- 7. Complete your installation of your decorative gas appliance.
- 8. Plumb for gas supply as indicated by your local building codes.
